Identifying Passive and Active Voice PASSIVE VOICE - The subject RECEIVES the action Example: The treasure was guarded by the fire-breathing

dragon ACTIVE VOICE - The subject PERFORMS the action Example: The fire-breathing dragon guarded the treasure PASSIVE VOICE always uses the past participle of the verb + auxiliary (helping) verbs

Lesson 15: Passive Voice In the active voice, the subject of the sentence DOES the action: Jake wrote a letter subject / verb / object In the passive voice, the subject of the sentence is acted upon: A letter was written (by Jake) subject / verb Notice that the object of the active sentence (letter) became the subject of the passive sentence
