-Fire at refinery that burned for 5 days and caused oil and fire fighting water to pollute the surrounding area and sea -costs for remediating environmental damage about \$578m (€722m), 95% of which was insured -Spill of 6 500 tonnes of acrylonitrile, a toxic substance from an acrylic fibre production facility

CASE STUDY ON FIRE INCIDENT AT VGO-HDT UNIT 10 THE INCIDENT: An incident of major fire occurred in VGO- HDT unit of a petroleum refinery leading to shutdown of the unit continued for about 4 hours Due to Fire the incident, the unit suffered major damages (shown below) and is under shutdown pending major repairs
